The Friends of the University of Newcastle have generously sponsored an Acquisitive Art prize of \$6,000. The development of the Art Prize assists in the growth of the University's Art Collection that will ensure that this public collection continues to provide our region with contemporary and relevant work for ours and future generations to enjoy. It is open to all artists in all media.

An award exhibition will profile the finalists during the week of 23 to 27 July 2014, with the announcement of the winning entry in the University Gallery on Friday 25 July at 5pm.

Entries must be submitted by 5pm 27 June 2014. No late entries will be considered.

The Friends of the University of Newcastle play a vital role in the development and support of scholarships for the University and fundraise consistently for various needs of the University's Community. The Friends of the University formed in 1981 and have successfully raised nearly \$1,000,000. Each odd-numbered year, the Friends of the University host a Book Fair and now work with the University Gallery to host a Biennial Acquisitive Art Prize in each even-numbered year.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Each artist may enter one work. The entry must be the original work of the artist and have been created in the last 2 Years.
2. The Friends of the University Acquisitive Art Prize 2014 will award one Acquisitive Prize of \$6,000 to the winning entrant as decided by a panel of judges.
3. The winning work will become the property of the University Art Collection upon payment of the prize money to the winning entrant. The prize money is the acquisition cost. Payments to the winner by the Friends of the University of Newcastle. Payments will be made by direct credit into the winning artist's nominated bank account.
4. The prize is open to any form of media, including but not limited to works on paper, painting, fibres and textiles, sculpture, installation and photography. The artist must provide details of the media used in the work on the entry form. There is no size restriction.
5. Multi panel pieces are accepted and are regarded as one work. Please specify if your work is part of a series on entry form. Such works should be accompanied by a photo of the assembled work.
6. Entries must be submitted including completed entry form, PLUS a JPEG image of the work (high resolution at 300dpi no larger than 20cm). DO NOT SEND ACTUAL ARTWORK with your entry form. Entries must be submitted by 5pm 27 June 2014.
7. Finalists will be advised of selection for the Prize exhibition by Monday 30 June 2014.

Should your work be selected for exhibition, artwork must be delivered at the artists' cost to:

The University Gallery will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever, and however caused, to any work while in transit. Each artist is responsible for maintaining their own insurance coverage for transport. The works will be covered by insurance while on exhibition in the gallery.

The judges will not have access to the identity of the entrants during the judging process and their decision will be final.

Please be aware if you are not awarded the Acquisitive Prize and you wish to sell your work, a 20% commission applies and will be given to the Friends of the University for further scholarships and prizes.
